What We Do:

In 2014, Creekmore Masonic Lodge raised and contributed over \$30,000 to charitable and education causes in Oklahoma and our local community.

Community Involvement

We raised more than \$17,000 to assist a local family with medical expenses.

We raised more than \$10,000 for the Regional Food Bank of Oklahoma which provides food for local distribution through Bread of Life Ministries.

We contributed toward a new ambulance for the Marshall County Ambulance Service.

We provided funds for scholarships to the Marshall County Junior Livestock Show Association.

Support of Public Education

We provided college scholarships in the amount of \$2000 to two graduating seniors at Madill High School. (\$4000 in total)

We recognized an outstanding teacher at Madill Public Schools as a *Masonic Teacher of Today* with a \$100 honorarium.

We recognized six outstanding students at Madill Public Schools as *Masonic Students of Today* with a \$100 scholarship each. (\$600 in total)

We provided an opportunity for senior students in Madill Public Schools to participate in the state wide Masonic Senior Essay Program and compete for cash awards.

We contributed funds to the Oklahoma Educational Television Authority through the Grand Master's annual fundraising effort.

Prevent Blindness Oklahoma

In 2014, Creekmore Masonic Lodge #74 assisted Prevent Blindness Oklahoma in vision screening over 5000 public school students in the following schools: Madill Public Schools, Marietta Public Schools, and Turner Public Schools. We also assisted other Masonic Lodges in screening at Kingston Public Schools and Tishomingo Public Schools. Over 20 percent of students screened were referred for treatment or to be fitted for eye glasses.

Creekmore Masonic Lodge #74 also hosted a training session to train other volunteers to assist in vision screening.
