



Creekmore Masonic Lodge #74 assists Vizavance (formerly Prevent Blindness Oklahoma) in vision screening over 5000 public school students in the following schools: Madill Public Schools, Marietta Public Schools, and Turner Public Schools. We have also assisted other Masonic Lodges in screening at <u>Kingston Public Schools</u> and <u>Tishomingo Public Schools</u>. Over 20 percent of students screened are referred for treatment or to be fitted for eye glasses.
