

Creekmore Masonic Lodge #74 assists **Vizavance** (formerly Prevent Blindness Oklahoma) in vision screening over 5000 public school students in the following schools: Madill Public Schools, Marietta Public Schools, and Turner Public Schools. We have also assisted other Masonic Lodges in screening at Kingston Public Schools and Tishomingo Public Schools. Over 20 percent of students screened are referred for treatment or to be fitted for eye glasses.
